

WARRANT FOR 2007 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

To: Melanie Hardy, a resident of the Town of Oakfield

GREETINGS:

In the Name of the State of Maine you are hereby requested to notify the inhabitants of Oakfield, qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Community Center, at the 250 Oakfield Smyrna Road, on Monday, December 3, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. to act on the following articles to wit:

Article 1

To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to borrow in anticipation of taxes for the first three months of Fiscal Year 2008.

Article 3

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to sell and dispose the Universalist Church and; to enter into a purchase and sale agreement with buyer on behalf of the town and take whatever other actions may be necessary.

Article 4

Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen, on behalf of the Town, to join with other participating municipal and quasi-municipal employers in Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement for the provision of employee health benefits, as authorized by 24-A M.R.S.A 6601 et seq., said Arrangement to be known as the "Maine Municipal Employees Health Trust" (Health Trust); and for that purpose and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements among participating employers, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a Participation Agreement on behalf of the Town and take whatever other actions may be necessary. The authority granted herein shall continue until revoked.

Article 5

To see if the town will vote to appropriate from available funds \$2900 for the Houlton Animal Shelter for fiscal year 2007.

Article 6

To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to sell and dispose the surplus Fire Truck to the Oakfield Firefighter Association.
